

## Kindergarten Stationery Kits

Dear Parents,

We are sharing with you Stationery Kits for your child for the upcoming academic year, 2022/23. In line with this, we are requesting and suggesting the following:

- Ensure that your child's stationery/equipment/clothing is clearly labeled - we are suggesting https://www.essmak.com/ They create durable and washable labels for children. Please note that we will require you to label your child's equipment and clothing, Essmak is a suggestion and you are welcome to explore other options.
- We are also suggesting that you buy some durable ziplock bags - labeled with your child's name to keep his/her belongings safe.
- Each child will be assigned a cubby and all equipment will be stored in there.
- Please ensure that your child is equipped with a backpack that can be worn over both shoulders. For safety reasons we do not allow children to have trolley bags.

1x basket/container to organize all your child's stationery/materials in

- stationery will stay in one class in your child's cubby. For health purposes, students will not be able to share stationery.

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[^0]| 1 Pencil case |  | 1 Construction paper, (A4), 50 sheets, Assorted Colors (x1 per quarter) |  |
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| HB pencils a pack of $x 3$ per quarter. <br> TRIPOD <br> (KG 1 - Gr. 1) |  | We suggest and prefer tripod pencils - they are 3-sided and a great tool for developing a good pencil grip. <br> Alternatively, you can purchase normal pencils and then buy pencil grips. Stationary stores stock different types of pencil grips. You and your child can decide what works best for you. |  |
| 1 Box crayons per quarter. (N - KG 2) <br> TRIPOD |  | Similarly to the pencils, we also suggest that you invest in tripod crayons to support the development of a good pencil grip. |  |
| 1 Box of Faber Castell colour pencils per quarter. <br> TRIPOD <br> (KG 1 - KG 2 only) |  | Similarly to the pencils, we also suggest that you invest in tripod colouring pencils to support the development of a good pencil grip. |  |
| Play Dough (N - KG. 2) | Purchase at least 2 colours. Please store this in an airtight container or ziplock back - clearly labeled with your child's name. | OR MAKE YOUR OWN: Here is a tried and tested recipe: Ingredients <br> 1 cup of flour <br> $1 / 4$ cup of salt <br> $3 / 4$ cup of water <br> 1 tablespoon vegetable oil <br> Food colouring of your choice <br> Instructions <br> 1. Add water and oil to a non stick pot and heat on medium heat <br> 2. Add food colouring <br> 3. In a mixing bowl, combine the flour and salt <br> 4. Continuously stir until the ingredients combine, dry out and begin to form a ball. If mixture is sticky just add more flour until the play-dough does not stick to your fingers <br> 5. Put play-dough in an airtight container/sandwich bag to prevent it from becoming dry - label it with your childs' name. |  |
